**William Flesch, Ph.D.**, is a professor of English at Brandeis, where he teaches courses on Shakespeare as well as the history of poetry. He is the author of "The Facts on File Companion to 19<sup>th</sup> Century English Poetry" (October, 2009), as well as of "Comeuppance: Costly Signaling, Altruistic Punishment and Other Biological Components of Fiction" (2008). He has many other publications, book articles as well as articles for the Boston Globe *Ideas* section. He is the recipient of three teaching awards at Brandeis and Cornell and a National Endowment of the Humanities Fellowship. "Billy" has led five previous Rapaport Seminars: Brandeis at BOLLI on King Lear, Hamlet, The Merchant of Venice, The Winter's Tale and Antony & Cleopatra – all to rave reviews.
