

# BRANDEIS WELLESLEY CONCERTO COMPETITION APPLICATION

Concerto Competition will take place at the end of the Spring semester. See the [orchestra web site](#) for exact date.

Deadline for submission will be APRIL 15. Please leave the completed form in Neal Hampton's mailbox in the music department office and email your intent to compete to Hampton@brandeis.edu.

- The competition is open to Brandeis and Wellesley students: **string and wind players must have played at least one year in the orchestra or, if applying at the end of their junior year having not played in orchestra, have committed to play during their entire senior year.**
- **Applicants must currently be studying with a teacher.** Teacher's signature or email confirmation is required and signifies the student has learned the concerto under the teacher's guidance.
- Single movements or entire works will be considered. Only complete movements that are performance ready at the time of the audition will be eligible for consideration. If you audition on one movement and win, you will play **only** that movement at the concert
- An outside adjudicator will rate the performances. Suitability of the work for the orchestra will be considered.
- All applicants must provide their own piano accompaniment. No unaccompanied auditions will be considered. The accompanist will truncate long orchestral interludes in the work.
- The winner(s) will play with the orchestra the following school year on a date to be determined by the director. Failure to be available for all rehearsals and performances may result in disqualification. Those selected to play with the orchestra are not eligible to apply again.
