

## Requirement CHECKLIST for Psychology Majors

(as of August, 2007)

Eleven courses are required for the major; all courses must have a grade of C- or better.

Note: Math 36b (Mathematical Statistics) or Econ 83a (Statistics for Economic Analysis) may be taken in place of Psyc 51a.

4. *Two Research Science Courses:*

**All students must take:**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Psyc 99d- Senior Research in Psychology
- \_\_\_\_\_ Phys 10a or 10b
- \_\_\_\_\_ Phys 11a or 11b
- \_\_\_\_\_ Phys 15a or 15b

**or a seminar that has been designated as “research intensive”** (meaning that it involves a significant independent research component). \_\_\_\_\_

5. *Two Advanced Seminars* (courses 100-level or above).

Note: Any seminar used to meet the quantitative or the research science requirement cannot also be counted towards the advanced seminar requirement.

Special Notes: The major will require a minimum of 9 of 11 courses in Psychology and/or Neuropsychology. An AP score of 5 may be used to count for up to 2 courses, from the following list: Introduction to Psychology, Statistics, Calculus, Computer Science, Chemistry, Physics, Biology.
