

## Differences Between BTACT (Form A) and ALTERNATE BTACT (Form B)

- Word List Immediate/Delayed
  - BTACT Form A: List A from a modified version of the Rey Auditory Verbal Learning Test (RAVLT; Rey, 1941; 1964)
  - BTACT Form B: List B from the RAVLT
- Digits Backwards
  - BTACT Form A: Seven possible trials, each consisting of 2 levels (WAIS III; Wechsler, 1997).
  - BTACT Form B: The second level of each trial was administered first.
- Category Fluency
  - BTACT Form A: Participants asked to name animals
  - BTACT Form B: Participants asked to name foods
- Stop & Go Switch Task
  - BTACT Form A: Trials for congruent (normal), incongruent (reverse), and mixed task conditions
  - BTACT Form B: Trials within each of the conditions were randomly re-ordered
- Number Series
  - BTACT Form A: Five items consisting of naming the next logical number in a given series (Salthouse & Prill, 1987)
  - BTACT Form : Each item changed to conform to the same patterns as those in Form A using different numbers
- Backward Counting
  - BTACT Form A and B: Participants given 30 seconds to count backwards from 100 as fast and as accurately as possible.
