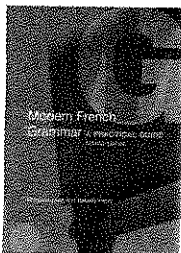

This Grammar is complemented by the *Modern French Grammar Workbook* Second Edition which features related exercises and activities.

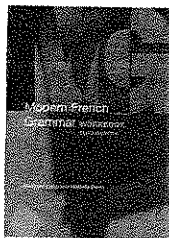

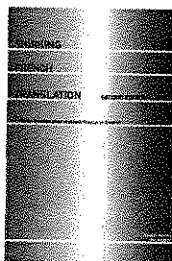
