Language Proficiency Requirement

To graduate, you will be required to have knowledge of a language in addition to English. You can satisfy this requirement through one of the following means: (1) native language is not English (2) taking two semesters of a language at Brandeis or Wellesley (3) taking two to four courses in the host language while studying abroad (4) taking an intensive language course such as Berlitz (5) demonstrating proficiency on a placement exam given by the language department at Brandeis. (Please contact the Student Services for arrangements) (6) other documented competency.

International Experience Requirement

The Lemberg Program requires students to have or gain substantial international experience before graduation. You can satisfy this requirement if you have:(1) lived outside of the United States for three or more years (2) worked abroad in a professional position for at least three months (3) studied abroad for a semester at one of our 20 partner universities (4) undertaken a rigorous internship outside the United States for 3 or more months.
