EMPLOYMENT

18% of Brandeis graduates enter the fields of business, consulting and finance each year.

Undergraduate students average **3 internships** before graduation.

98% of employers who hired Brandeis students for academic internships in 2010 indicated that they would hire Brandeis students again.

ACADEMICS

400 students major in business and economics at Brandeis.

Incoming students' Math SAT scores range from **650 - 740 (25th - 75th percentiles)**.

450 graduate students are pursuing MBA, MS in Finance, and MA in International Economics and Finance degrees at the International Business School (IBS) at Brandeis.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

More than **200 students** from Brandeis and partner schools attend the annual *Business, Consulting and Finance Forum*, sponsored by the Hiatt Career Center.

Brandeis has one of the largest ALPFA student chapters in the country with **over 100 members**.
