EMPLOYMENT

25% of Brandeis graduates enter the fields of biotech, healthcare, science research, public policy, and service.

Undergraduate students average **3 internships** before graduation.

98% of employers who hired Brandeis students for academic internships in 2010 indicated that they would hire Brandeis students again.

ACADEMICS

300+ undergraduate and graduate students major or concentrate in health and policy at Brandeis.

Over 100 undergraduates have been published in peer-review faculty journals since 2001.

75% of Brandeis alumni who apply to health profession schools are accepted, more than **20% higher** than the national average.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

More than 200 students from Brandeis and partner schools attend the annual *Public Health Forum* as well as the annual *Biotech, Healthcare & Science Forum*, both sponsored by the Hiatt Career Center.

There are **over 250 active student-run clubs** on campus, including Amnesty International, Foundation for International Medical Relief of Children, Health Occupations Students of America, and Student Global AIDS Campaign.
