

**Hornstein BA/MA Curriculum
2009 - 2011**

Requirements for BA/MA Degree: This combined degree, leading to a Master of Arts in Jewish Professional Leadership, requires 56 credit hours. 32 credits are taken as Hornstein credits (14 during the undergraduate senior year and 18 during the 5th graduate year), 4 as NEJS credits for the final project, and 20 as elective credits. Elective courses are taken during the summer, fall and spring following the senior undergraduate year, must be at or above the 100 level, and should include a course on the history of Israel (if not already taken during the undergraduate years.)

Hebrew Requirement: All students are required to demonstrate proficiency in modern Hebrew at a level comparable to two years of Brandeis training in order to graduate. Students not meeting this requirement upon entrance are required to enroll in courses in Hebrew language during their academic residency. Students may fulfill the Hebrew language requirement by passing (B- or above) a 40-level or higher Hebrew course. An intensive four-week Hebrew program is also available to students in the summer through the Brandeis Hebrew Language Summer Institute.
