

**Hornstein/Heller MBA Curriculum

**Requirements for Dual MBA/MA Degree:** The dual degree requires 80 credit hours, usually completed in five semesters, including the summer between years one and two. Approximately 34 credits are taken as Hornstein credits, and 38 as Heller credits. 8 additional elective credits are also required, 4 of which must be related to the study of modern Israel.

**Hebrew Requirement:** All students are expected to know the Hebrew alphabet prior to beginning their studies. Fluency in Hebrew at a level comparable to one year of college training is required for graduation. Students not meeting this requirement upon entrance are required to enroll in courses in Hebrew language in their first year and, or if necessary, during the summer after the first year. An intensive four-week Hebrew preparatory program is available to students in the summer prior to their enrollment through the Brandeis Hebrew Language Summer Institute, and is highly recommended.
