NEJS Requirements for Dual MA Degree: This dual degree requires 80 credits, usually completed in five semesters, including the summer between years one and two. Approximately 32 credits are taken as Hornstein courses and 36 credits taken as NEJS courses. 12 additional elective credits are also required, 4 of which must be related to the study of modern Israel.

Hebrew Requirement: All degree candidates are required to demonstrate proficiency in modern Hebrew. An intensive four-week Hebrew preparatory program is available to students in the summer prior to their enrollment through the Brandeis Hebrew Language Summer Institute, and is highly recommended. Students may fulfill the Hebrew language requirement by either:
 1. scoring high enough on the pre-matriculation written and oral placement assessment to "place out" of the requirement, or
 2. passing (B- or above) a 40- or higher level Hebrew course at Brandeis.
