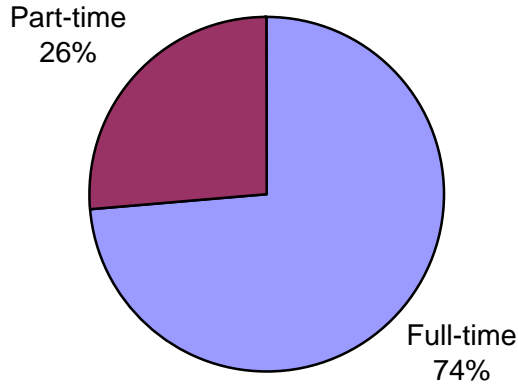
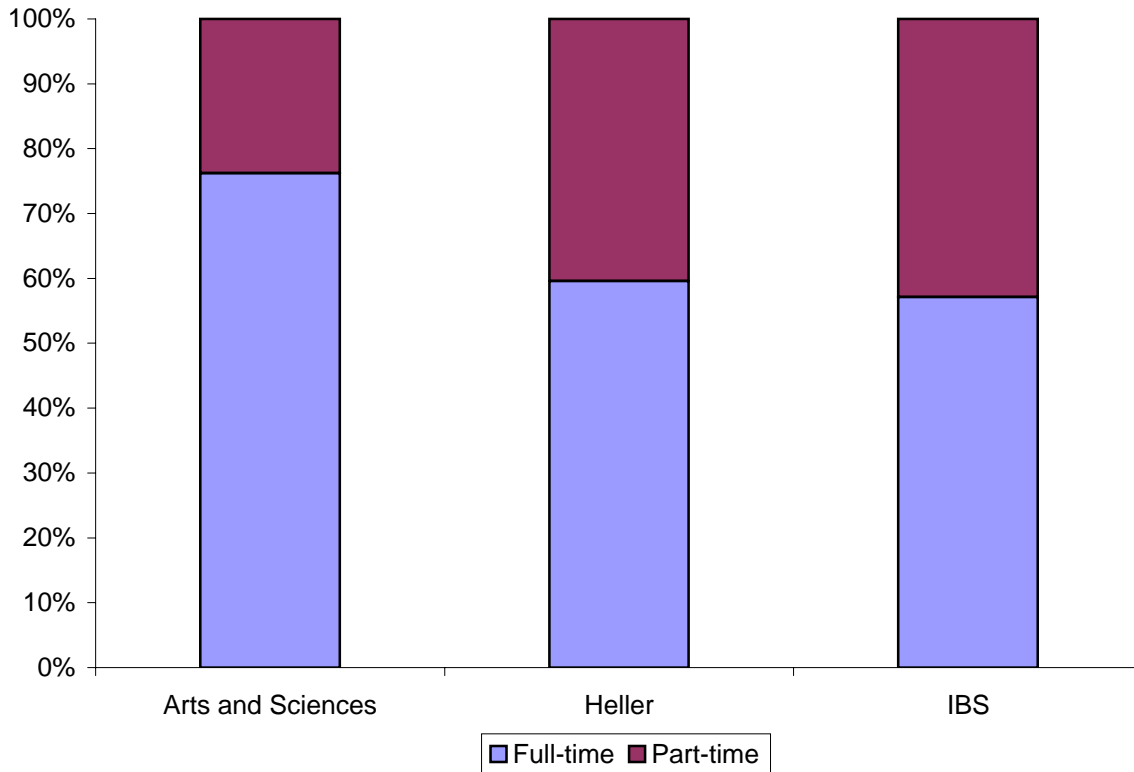

Full-time vs. Part-time



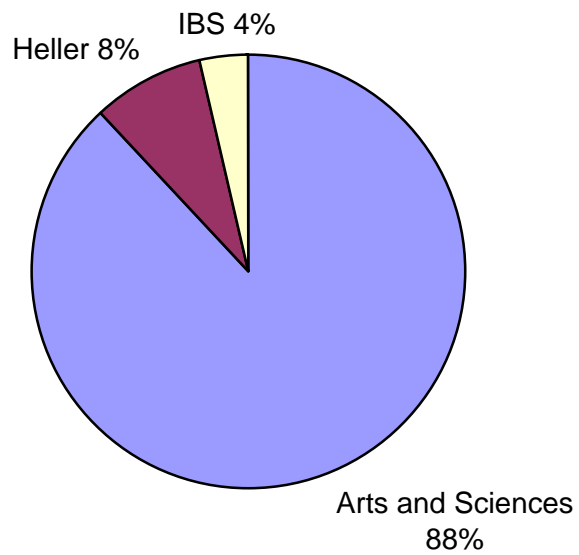

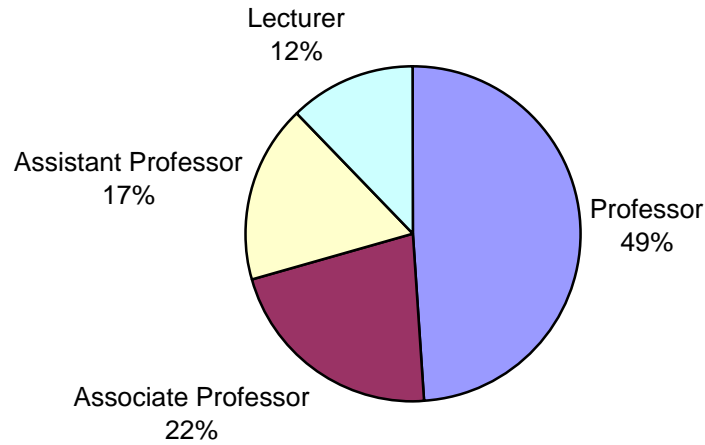

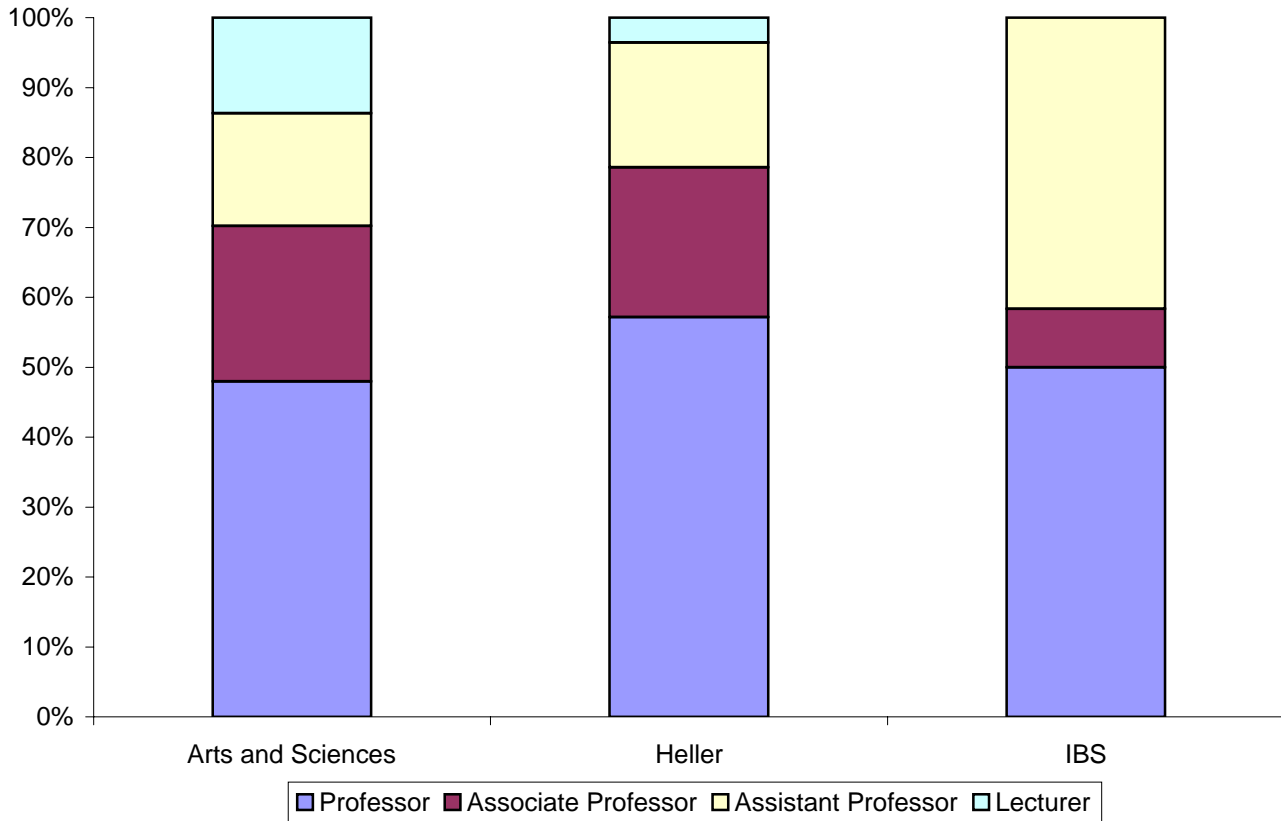

Rank of Full-time Instructional Faculty Fall 2004



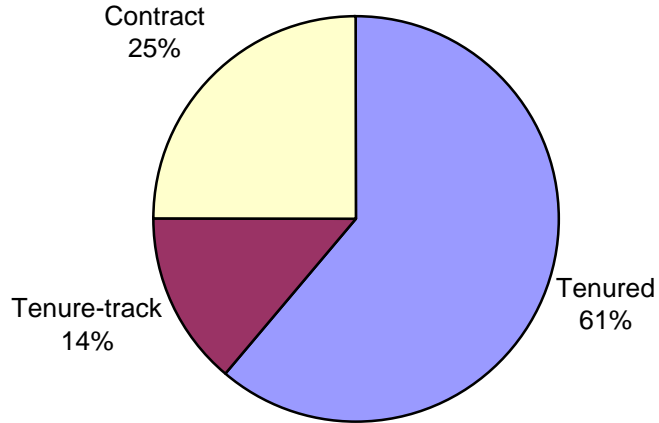

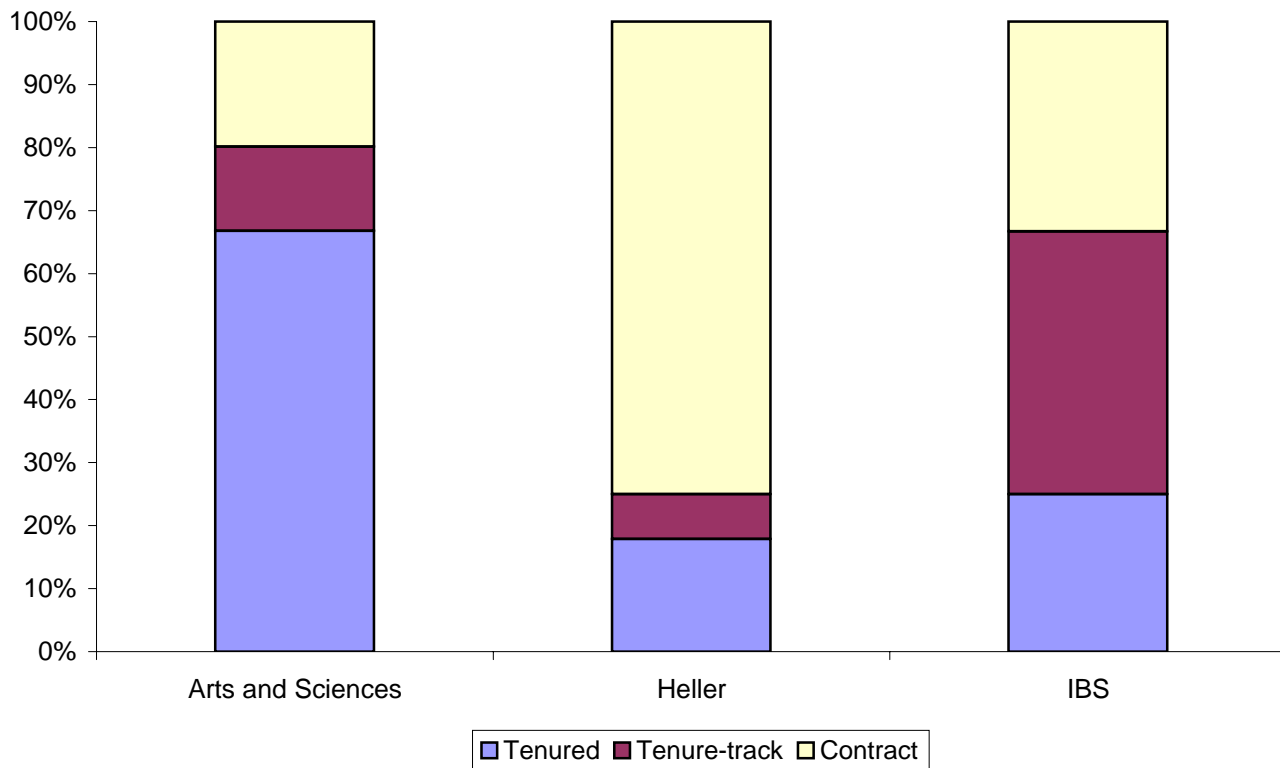

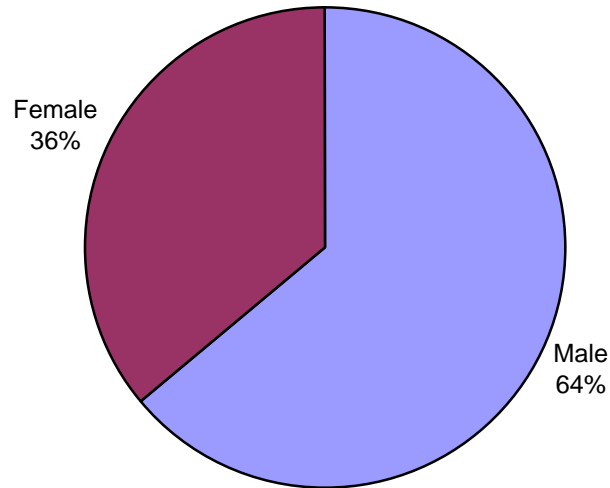

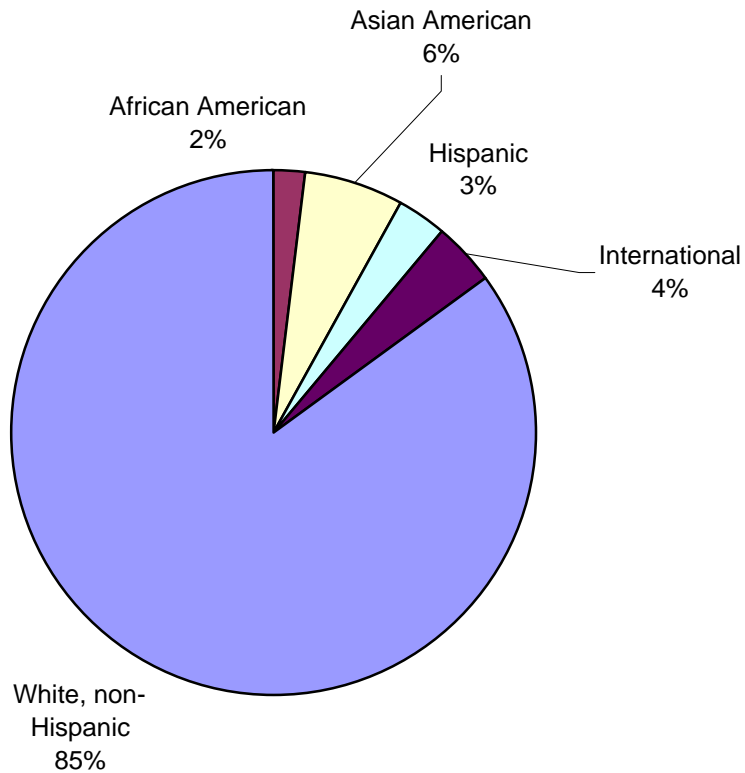

Gender



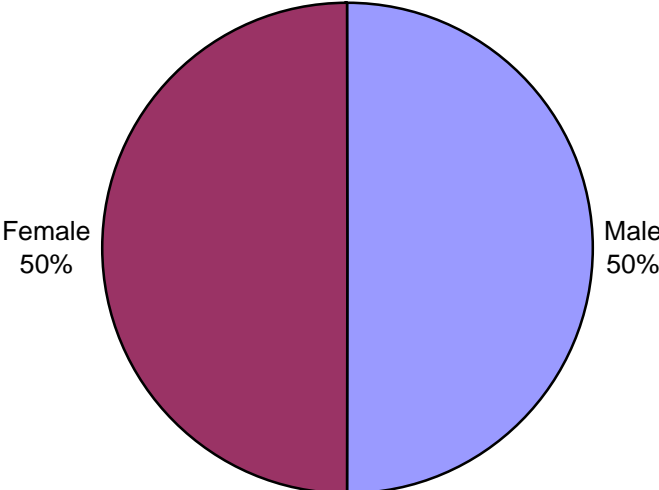
Ethnicity



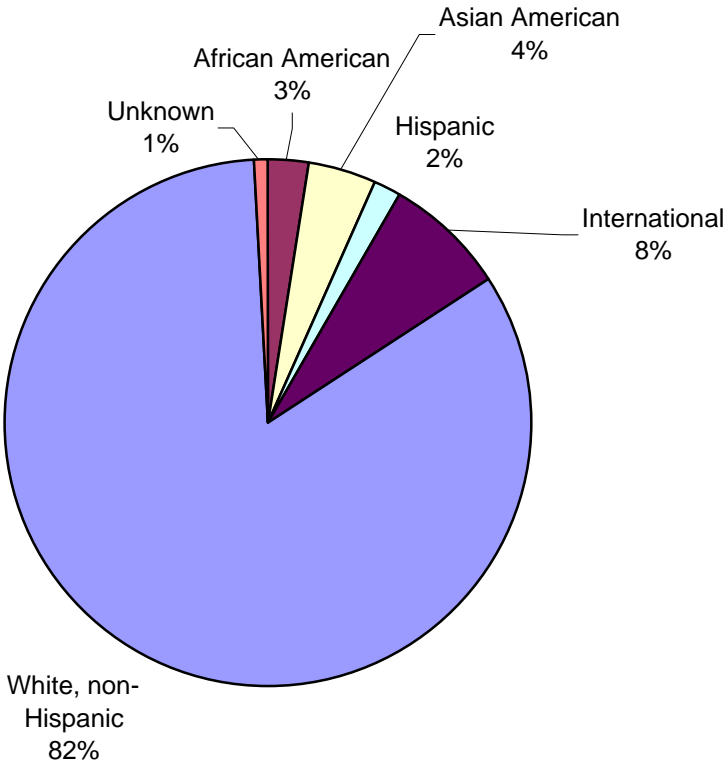

Gender and Ethnicity of Part-time Instructional Faculty Fall 2004

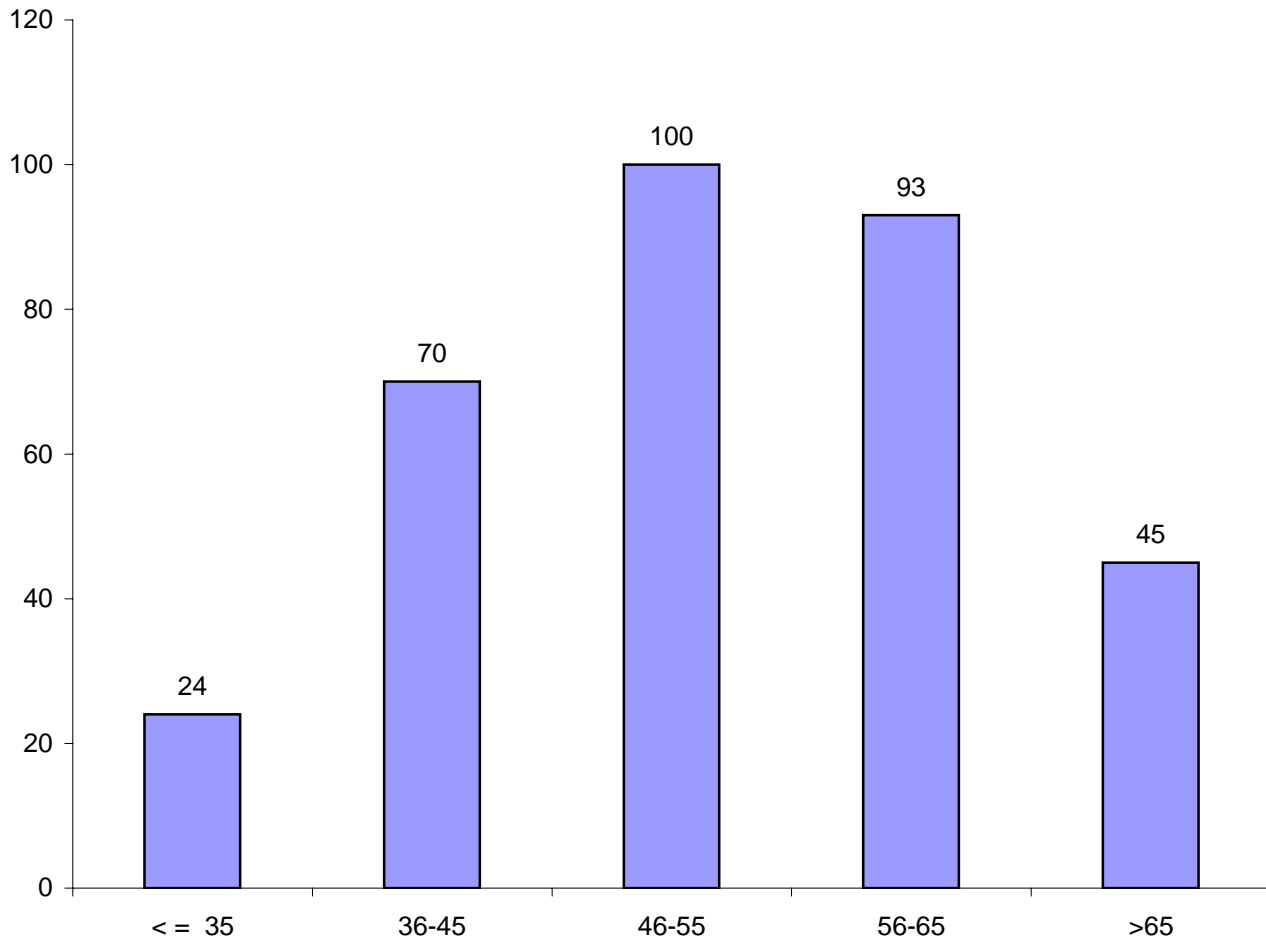
