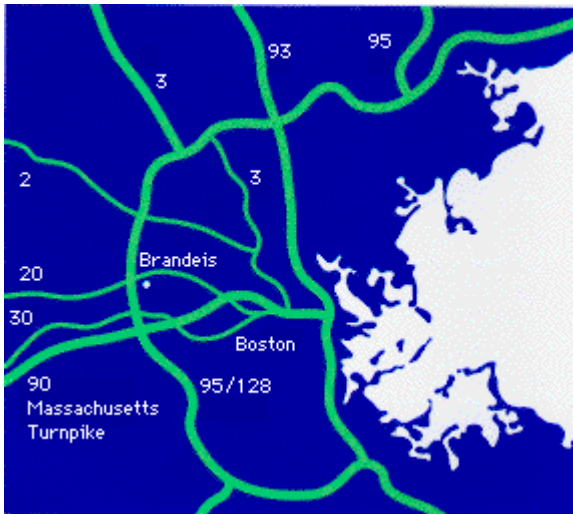


# Directions to Hassenfeld Conference Center – Levine Ross & Luria Rooms – at Brandeis University

## DIRECTIONS TO BRANDEIS UNIVERSITY

Brandeis is located just 10 miles west of Boston and is accessible by both car and MBTA transit:



---

From the **Massachusetts Turnpike (Interstate 90) Eastbound**: Take exit 14 for I-95/Rt 128. After the toll, keep left for 95/128 North. While on ramp, exit immediately onto exit 24 for Route 30. Bear left onto Route 30. Turn right at first traffic light. This is South Street, and Brandeis is two miles ahead on left.

---

From the **Massachusetts Turnpike (Interstate 90) Westbound**: Take exit 15 for I-95/Rt 128 and Route 30. After the toll proceed straight for Route 30. Turn right at end of the ramp, and then right again at first traffic light onto Route 30. Turn left at next traffic light. This is South Street, and Brandeis is two miles ahead on the left.

---

From **I-95/Route 128 Southbound**: Take exit 24 for Route 30. At end of ramp, proceed through traffic light (across Route 30). This is South Street, and Brandeis is two miles ahead on the left.

---

From **I-95/Route 128 Northbound**: Take exit 24 for Route 30. Turn left at the top of the ramp onto Route 30. Turn right at the traffic lights. This is

South Street, and Brandeis is two miles ahead on the left.

---

By **Commuter Rail**: Commuter train service is available from Boston's North Station (Fitchburg / South Acton line) to the Brandeis/Roberts Station which borders the campus. Check [MBTA commuter rail schedules](http://www.mbt.com) [http://www.mbt.com] for more information.

---

By **MBTA Bus**: The 553 bus runs directly to Brandeis Campus and South Street, while the 70 bus stops near campus. For more information on times and transfers, use the [MBTA rider tool](#). Entering **415 South St. Waltham, MA 02454** as your destination, you can find the most appropriate route for you.

## DIRECTIONS TO PARKING AND HASSENFELD CONFERENCE CENTER

At the Brandeis Main Entrance stop at the guard booth and ask for a T Lot area parking pass, then take a left turn. Follow signs to Parking. For those walking follow signs to Hassenfeld Conference Center.

---

To **Parking**: At the first stop sign take a left and proceed into the parking lot **T** behind the Spingold Theater. From this lot you will walk to Hassenfeld Conference Center (about 5 minutes). Walk up the steps on the left side of Spingold Theatre. Take a left onto the roadway and stay on the right side of the road. Following signs to Hassenfeld Conference Center, take the first entrance on the right into Hassenfeld Conference Center. Lurias 1, 2, & 3 and Levine-Ross 1 & 2 are on your left and right respectively.

---

To **HP Parking**: Continue on the main roadway, past Spingold Theater on left and Shapiro Campus Center on right, following the curve of the road to the right. On your left will be the Rose Art Museum, continue and on your left will be two (2) parking spaces marked **HP**. Further along the road, about 100 feet is the walkway to Hassenfeld Conference Center on the right. If needed, there is additional parking for HP, proceed another 100 feet on the left, to lot **H**.
