

Phoebe Giddon '56 and Dr. Donald Giddon Grant for Research on Women and Health

Stipend and Duties

The grant may be applied to any expense directly associated with the research project.

Eligibility

This grant will be awarded for the undergraduate or graduate project deemed best able to contribute new knowledge or understanding to a topic concerning women and health. You do not have to be enrolled in the Women's and Gender Studies Program to apply for the grant. The proposal may be connected to a senior thesis, a course project, a master's paper, or a dissertation, may involve research in biological or social science, humanities or creative arts, and may use qualitative or quantitative methods as appropriate. Topics could include, but are not limited to, women's physical or psychological health, women's health in a global context, women and health care, treatment, awareness, or prevention.

Completed Application Includes:

- Applicant information sheet (application and complete details available at www.brandeis.edu/wgs or at the Women's and Gender Studies Program Office, Rabb 105)
- A brief synopsis (approximately 300-500 words) of the research project with bibliography and itemized budget
- A statement of the relationship of the research to the student's overall course of study
- The signature of a faculty advisor who approves the project proposal
- A copy of the student's transcript

Evaluation

Applications are evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

- The strength and coherence of the project
- The project's significance for the field of women and health
- The student's demonstrated knowledge of relevant research sources and skills required to perform research (i.e. skills in quantitative methods, knowledge of foreign language, etc.)
