The Giller-Sagan Prize was established in 1982 by Frimi and Eli Sagan, in honor of the grandmothers of Susannah Sagan '81. Sadie Giller and Esther Sagan left the shtetl in their teens and came to America in search of a promising and complex life. In honor of these women, this prize is awarded each year to a Women's and Gender Studies senior major or minor for their exceptional undergraduate paper.

- All WMGS 198a undergraduate papers or senior honors theses will be considered for the prize
- Minors may submit a paper that follows the WMGS 198a paper guidelines
