

## **The Future of the Rose Committee Meeting April 7, 2009**

### **Summary**

The Committee briefly discussed the Town Hall meeting scheduled to take place on Tuesday, April 21<sup>st</sup>, from 4:30 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Marty Krauss, Provost, joined the meeting to consult with the Committee about plans for the Rose during the interim period—after June 30<sup>th</sup> and before the Committee makes its recommendations and the Board makes its decisions. The Committee offered feedback and endorsed the proposed interim plan. When the details of the plan are finalized, an announcement will be sent to the Brandeis community.

Committee members refined the draft faculty survey instrument and discussed outreach to constituencies. The Committee discussed feedback from the alumni board president and executive board of the alumni association. Committee members considered a list of outside experts who could be contacted and questions to be asked of them. Several committee members will take the lead on the outreach to outside experts. The Committee also hopes to learn from the experiences of other institutions in situations similar to Brandeis's situation.

The Committee will proceed with outreach to various constituencies and will meet again after the Passover break.
