



Breadth Requirement Form Ph.D. Program in Psychology

Breadth Requirement: Before submitting their dissertation proposal, all students must demonstrate *breadth* in the field of psychology by showing competence in at least **six** of the subject areas cited below, by passing an advanced undergraduate (equivalent of Brandeis 100+ level course) or graduate-level course, with a grade of B or higher, at Brandeis or elsewhere. Of the six area requirements, students must take at least two courses from group A and at least two from group B. Students on the BBB track must take at least two courses from each group (A, B and C).
