- ❖ **Mellon Dissertation Research Grants**
A grant of up to \$3,000 for research-related travel, duplication services, and other expenditures.
- ❖ **Mellon Dissertation Year Fellowships**
A one-year stipend of \$20,000 plus a summer stipend of \$3,000 and a research fund of \$2,000. Only fifth or sixth-year students may apply for this fellowship.
- ❖ **Provost Award**
An award of up to \$1,000 in support of a doctoral candidate's dissertation-related research expenses.
- ❖ **Redstone Dissertation Year Fellowships**
A one-year stipend of \$17,000 for doctoral candidates who have completed all requirements other than the dissertation. Only seventh or eighth-year students may apply for this fellowship.
- ❖ **Sachar Award**
An award of up to \$1,500 in support of a doctoral candidate's research abroad.
- ❖ **Tauber Institute for the Study of European Jewry Research Grant**
- ❖ **University Prize Instructorship**
Gives Graduate School students the opportunity to design and teach an upper-division course in their field of research.

Applicants should have completed all doctoral requirements, except for the completion of their thesis, and must show evidence of being able to complete their thesis within the fellowship year.
