Intro Psychology	PSYC 10a (fall, spring)
Human Anatomy with lab	BIOL 43b (spring) – prereq: BIOL 15b & 16a
Human Physiology with lab	BIOL 42a & 42b (fall, summer) – <i>prereq: BIOL 15b & 14a</i>
Statistics	MATH 8a (fall, spring, summer) OR BIOL 51a (spring) – prereq: BIOL 14a & BIOL 15b OR PSYC 51a (fall, spring, summer) – prereq: PSYC 10a or instructor permission

REQUIRED BY SOME PROGRAMS

Course Subjects	Course Numbers and Semesters Offered
Genetics	BIOL 14a covers the core concepts of genetics and satisfies this requirement. If you would like an in-depth course in genetics, take either BIOL 72a or 128a.
2 semesters of English/Writing	 UWS Any English dept. course A course in a related department with literature in the title (e.g., HSSP 118: Viewing medicine and Health Policy through the lens of literature A non-science designated WI and taught in the English language
Organic Chemistry I with lab	CHEM 25a (fall, summer) – <i>prereq: CHEM 11b or 15b</i> CHEM 29a lab (fall, summer)
Biochemistry	BCHM 88b (fall, summer) – prereq: BIOL 14a & 15a; 1 year of organic chem. w/lab

	BCHM 100a (fall, spring) – prereq: 1 year of organic chem w/lab
Medical Terminology	Not offered
