- \*English/Writing Complete the requirement for 2 semesters of English in these ways:
- 1) UWS
- 2) Any course in the English department (does not have to be WI)
- 3) A course in a related department with literature in the title (Ex: HSSP 118: Viewing Medicine and Health Policy Through the Lens of Literature)
- 4) A course designated as WI outside of the sciences and in the English language. (HSSP 89 & Psyc 52 do not count.)
- \*MA residents without AP credit should take Math 10a to meet University of Massachusetts Medical School requirement.

Prerequisite courses vary from school to school. It's very important that you check the websites of schools you know you want to apply to in order to make sure you're taking the courses they require. The courses in this table are a summary of the most common requirements.
