"13th" is a documentary directed by Ava DuVernay that explores the history and impact of the 13th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution, which abolished slavery. Through interviews with scholars, activists, and politicians, "13th" delves into the intersection of race, justice, and the criminal justice system in America.
