Purpose of data acquired from lists

CMJS will conduct the that will provide actionable data to local community organizations for use in planning, programming, and outreach.

Our approach to sample design divides the local Jewish community into two conceptual groups: those who are already affiliated with one or more Jewish organizations as defined by their presence on a mailing or membership list (i.e., the "known" community), and those who are unaffiliated with any Jewish organizations (i.e., the "unknown" community). The sampling frame for the known community will draw from the mailing/membership lists of cooperating organizations in the local Jewish community (e.g., Federation, JCCs, synagogues, schools, advocacy organizations, etc.). To the extent that lists from different Jewish organizations may include different sets of households, these lists will be standardized, combined into a single list, and deduplicated to the extent possible so that no household will appear more than once but all contact information will be preserved. (Deduplication removes additional listings of already included households to avoid over representing those found on multiple lists.) This combined and deduplicated list will constitute affiliated households, or the "known" Jewish community (i.e., households that are known to at least one Jewish organization in the local area). The quality of the sample frame depends upon the willingness of community organizations to provide these lists.

Confidential Information

CMJS hereby acknowledges that any lists it receives or obtains from Jewish organizations during the course of this study shall be considered confidential. Further, to the extent CMJS receives these lists from a third party or directly from local Jewish organization, CMJS agrees to share data only with its research partner, NORC at the University of Chicago, and not to share such lists with the study sponsors or third parties. CMJS reserves the right to share results that it may derive

from analysis of the lists. CMJS hereby agrees and agrees to require all third party recipients to agree that it will not further use or disclose the Jewish organizational lists, including any lists provided by the study sponsor.

CMJS retains the right to refuse to accept any such information which it does not consider to be essential to the completion of the project or which it believes to be improperly designated, or for any other reason.

Where CMJS does accept such information as confidential, it shall not publish or otherwise reveal the information to others outside the CMJS team, the NORC team, and associated CMJS and NORC personnel, unless the information has already been published or disclosed publicly by third parties without fault on the part of CMJS or is required to be disclosed by order of a court of law. In addition, no information submitted by _______ shall be shared with other participating organizations and will not be used for any purpose other than to conduct the study referenced herein.
