PROGRAM OPTIONS

9 MONTHS

Two semesters of coursework, including a required field project, designed for candidates with a finance background and relevant work experience.

16 MONTHS

Three semesters of coursework, including a required internship or field project. Candidates can hone their skills by selecting one of four concentrations.
