## Hebrew 20: Intermediate Hebrew Asynchronous Class:

Continuation of the beginning Hebrew course, employing the same methods. Intensive training in Hebrew grammar, listening comprehension, speaking, reading, and writing. 4 university academic credit.

Both courses are taught asynchronously, which means there is no designated day or time assigned to the course (although there is one optional synchronous session with the instructor, as well as virtual office hours or discussion groups).
