What is it?

In any complex situation, no one perspective is enough to understand the whole. To see the whole requires multiple perspectives.

What is it used for/ Purpose?

Cone in a box is a visual that is used to


- Help participants gain self-awareness regarding the limitations of having only one perspective.
- Create curiosity about other people's perspectives, based on their professional roles and/or their social identities.
- A good way to motivate Humble Inquiry, Conversations of Difference and Conversations of Interdependence
