3. Brandeis University reserves the right to grant or deny permission to quote from or publish Fannie Hurst materials.

4. Brandeis University reserves the right to assess a use fee for any form of publication of Fannie Hurst materials. Unless otherwise specified, permissions to quote from or publish from Brandeis University are granted for one-time, non-exclusive, single-edition rights only.

5. Published work created using Fannie Hurst materials must include a citation indicating that Brandeis University and Washington University in St. Louis are joint copyright holders to the material.

6. Brandeis University requires that a complete copy of any publication (in any medium) that is based on Fannie Hurst materials be given to Brandeis University Libraries for inclusion in its collections.

7. The patron will defend and hold harmless (1) Brandeis University, its Brandeis University Libraries and the Robert D. Farber University Archives & Special Collections Department, its Board of Trustees, its officers, employees, and agents, and against all claims, demands, costs, and expenses including attorneys' fees incurred for any and all claims of copyright infringement or any other legal or regulatory course of action arising from the patron's use of Fannie Hurst materials.
