The Copyright Act of 1978 (17 U.S.C. secs. 101 et al.) provides statutory protection for all writings from the dates of their creation, whether or not they are formally published or copyrighted. - 6. Limited photocopying and photographic services are available upon request. The Brandeis University Libraries reserves the right to refuse to copy an item if such copying may damage the material or violate any Brandeis University policies and restrictions.
- 7. Charges for reproduction, handling, mailing and other related services are borne by the applicant. A one-time use fee will be charged for each specific project. Further use of a copy or copies for another project or purpose requires a new application for permission and payment of additional fees (see **Fee schedule**).
