NADAV TAMIR HAS DEDICATED HIS CAREER TO PUBLIC SERVICE, JOINING THE ISRAELI FOREIGN MINISTRY IN 1993 AND SERVING IN MULTIPLE ROLES, INCLUDING POLITICAL OFFICER AT THE ISRAELI EMBASSY IN WASHINGTON, DC. IN 2006, HE WAS NAMED ISRAELI CONSUL GENERAL TO NEW ENGLAND, A POSITION HE HELD UNTIL 2010. UPON RETURNING TO ISRAEL, HE JOINED THE POLICY PLANNING UNIT OF THE ISRAELI FOREIGN MINISTRY WHERE HE SERVED UNTIL ACCEPTING THE POSITION OF SENIOR ADVISER TO THE PRESIDENT UNDER SHIMON PERES. NADAV IS AN ADVISER FOR INTERNATIONAL AND GOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS AT THE PERES CENTER FOR PEACE AND INNOVATION WHERE HE HAS BEEN A KEY WITNESS AND ACTIVIST TO HOW THE CENTER HAS REACHED NEW HEIGHTS IN BINDING THE WORLD OF PEACE AND INNOVATION FOR A PROSPEROUS FUTURE.

NADAV EARNED HIS MA FROM THE HARVARD KENNEDY SCHOOL OF GOVERNMENT AS A WEXNER FELLOW AND HIS BA IN PHILOSOPHY AND POLITICAL SCIENCE FROM THE HEBREW UNIVERSITY.
