Scoring Your Assessment and Recommendation

Once you have completed the assessment, score your results by assigning 1 point for *each part of each problem* that you answer correctly. If you score,

1. **10 or fewer** points, we recommend taking the physics 11 sequence
2. **between 11 or 20** points, we recommend taking the physics 15 sequence
3. **21 or more** points, you may be prepared for physics 20
