Tier Requirement:

- Students are expected to TF for at least one course in each of the tiers 1-3 before graduating.
- Students who have not completed their teaching requirements will be given preference over students seeking CA placements in tier 1 or tier 2 courses.
- Advanced students, who have at least 3 previous placements, will be given preference for tier 3 courses
- The tier 4 placement is reserved for one CA only, and would involve a minimum commitment of two semesters
