<p>Masters Project Readings begins with the submission of a thesis proposal by Jan. 31st, and culminates in a master's thesis. The thesis may be in the form of an empirical research project, or a comprehensive literature review. In consultation with your advisor, you must choose a second reader for your project from within the Psychology Department. The final written thesis must be completed and submitted to your advisor and second reader one month prior to the Registrar's deadline (ref. link to academic calendar found in this document).</p>
