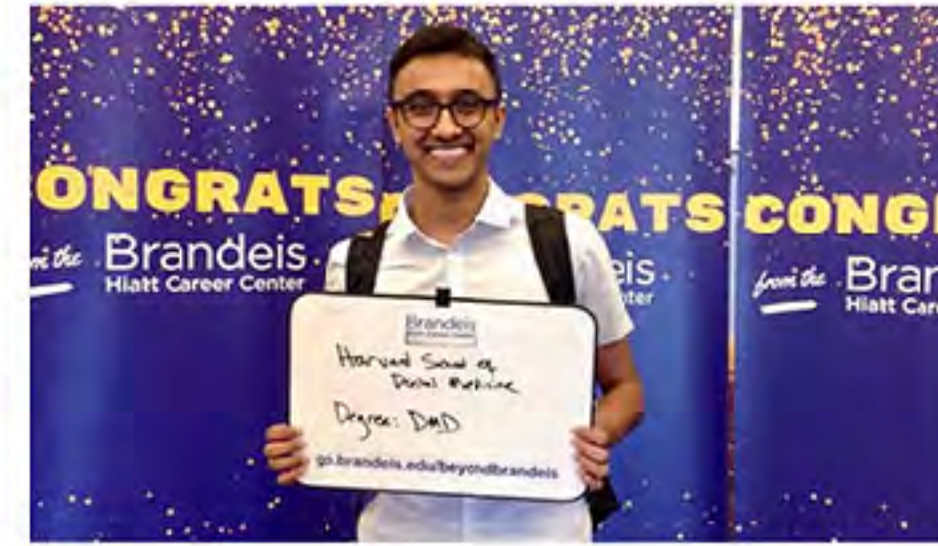

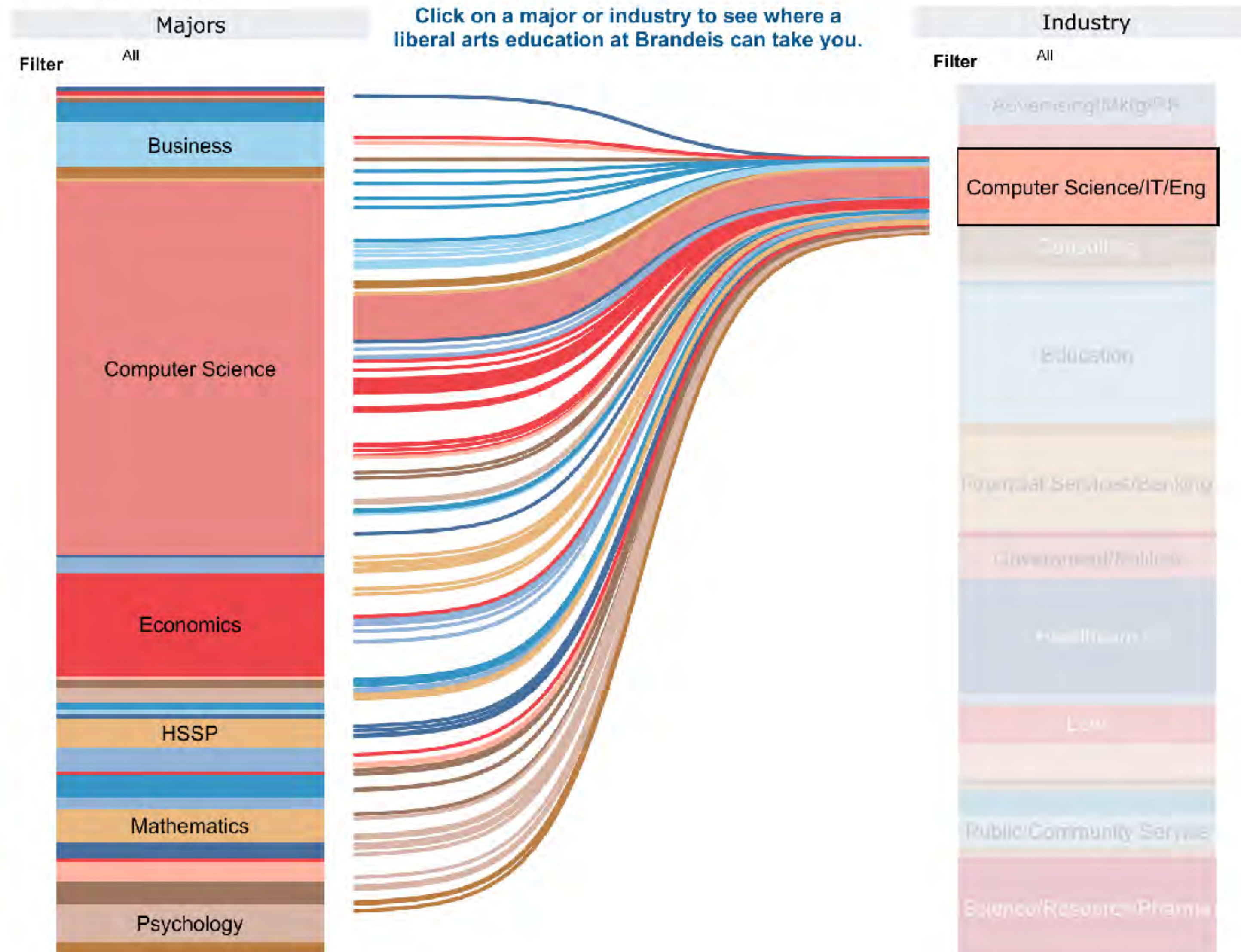


# Explore Majors
